WHAT DOES A PANTRY RESTOCK DO?

As a clothing closet volunteer, you will help organize and straighten the closet for the youth before the Center opens.

- Restock the low or empty necessities; underwear, socks, t-shirts
- Rehang clothing that has fallen off the hangers
- Tidy shelves and cubbies by refolding clothing
- Organize shoes by size and style
