Program and mission engagement - building and empowering our youth is what we do.

- (Previously shared) Due to the realities of our space and the time of our youth meals, gathering together on August 1st for our board meeting is not realistic. - As of this week, all apartments were filled at HOPE Place. In our attempt to improve the culture and expectations with our residents, we have seen more youth departing. While this impacts our financial state short term, the need to work with youth who are willing to engage in the program requirements are imperative.
- We continue to see increased mental health issues and youth in crisis. We have close ties with crisis support partners and are currently researching how else and where else to partner. This will be a priority discussion at our next board meeting.

Fall Board Retreat – thank you for your nimbleness in our rescheduled retreat.

In light of our facility dream being put on hold with the legislation stall, we are reimagining our future. Between now and our September retreat, we are meeting as staff and researching vision options for the board to discuss as we prepare for our next three-year strategic plan.
